## Thurmont Conservation & Sportsman's Club Rimfire Sporter Clinic and Match 2020

**Location & Directions:** Thurmont, Maryland. From Frederick – Take Rt. 15 North to Old Frederick Rd, bear right and exit, straight to Hunt Club Rd, make right, come to "T" in road, and make a right, straight into TCSC grounds. The gate will be open, follow gravel road to the clubhouse. The clinic will be held in the clubhouse.

Competition open to: Open invitation. All participants under 18 MUST have a parent or guardian present. All competitors must have a notarized "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" on file at the TCSC. A Notary <u>may</u> be available during match registration. What to Bring: Any .22 caliber rimfire (NO .22 WMR) rifle weighing less than 7.5 lbs with a trigger pull greater than 3 lbs. Rifle cannot or adjustable comb/butt stock. 100 rounds of .22 caliber rimfire ammo, shooting mat and/or ground tarp, eye and hearing protection. See https://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Rimfire.pdf?ver=20180406 for details. Empty Chamber Indicators (ECIs) are required for the match and clinic. ECIs will be available for purchase if needed. You may want to bring an empty notebook binder to the clinic for course materials. There will be live fire practice at the clinic.

**Match Course:** Unlimited sighters for 10 minutes and 60 shots for record. Usually 100 rounds of any .22 ammo is sufficient. Three classes O, T and Tactical. You may shoot all three classes per event, provided there is enough room for at least one match per contestant.

09/05/20, 10/04/20 and 11/21/20 events will use the 50-foot course in the large pistol bay with correct reduced targets. 10/31/20 event will use the 50-yard course on the rifle range.

Ammunition: Competitors must use their own ammunition provided it is deemed safe by the Match Director.

Clinic Fee: Free to all! Match Fee: \$10.00 21 and older for first event of the day: \$5.00 under 21 and each re-entry for all

Clinic Date/Time: Begins at 8:00am 08/22/20 at the clubhouse and will end about 4:00pm. Bring a lunch!! Clinic is highly recommended for first time participants. Limit 10 persons so preregister with scrowe@citlink.net.

Match Registration: Opens at 8:00am. Competitors must be at the range on or before 8:45 AM to participate!

Firing Starts: 9:00am, promptly.

Rules: Per CMP Competitions Rule Book.

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze awards based on scores

General Information: Bring a bag lunch or snack items and something to drink. Soft drinks may be available for purchase during the match. It is recommended to wear loose, comfortable clothing appropriate for the outside conditions (i.e. sweater, hat, gloves, sun block). Alcohol will not be consumed during the match, if discovered; competitor will be disqualified and removed from the range.
