Notes and Abbreviations Used for Events

- 2-Gun = 2-Gun uses a Rifle and Pistol
- 3-Gun = 3-Gun uses a Rifle, Shotgun and Pistol
- AIM = Academics, Integrity & Marksmanship - is a youth ATA Program
- ATA = Amateur Trapshooting Association. No shotgun shot larger the 7 1/2 is permitted on Trap Field. No slugs
- ATA Big 50 = Tuesday or Friday ATA Trap Shoot of 50 rds each of singles & handicap from 6:00 PM
- Club Open Trap Shoot every Tuesday & Friday from 6:00 to 10:00 PM, starting in January and ending in December
- CMP = Civilian Marksmanship Program (M1 Garand, 1903 Springfield, M1 Carbine) - 3 position shooting
- CMP Rimfire = Civilian Marksmanship Program for 22 LR caliber rifles
- Cops & Cowboys = CAS match with cops & cowboys shooting their firearms
- IDPA = International Defensive Pistol Association
- Mosin = Russian Mosin and any military rifle 3 position shooting
- MSSA -- Information only - shooting is on MSSA grounds and does not affect our events
- MSSA = Maryland State Sportsman's Association (governs Maryland ATA Trap)
- SASS-CAS = Single Action Shooting Society - Cowboy Action Shooting using Single Action Revolvers, 1800 Lever Rifle & 12/20 ga 1800 Shotgun
- SASS-MDS = SASS Championship - Mason-Dixon Stampede
- SASS-Wild Bunch = Similar to Cowboy w/ 1911 45 Auto semi-auto pistol, 45 Colt lever rifle & 12 ga 1897 Shotgun or Winchester Model 12 Shotgun
- Schuetzen = Shooting vintage or vintage style single shot rifles
- Swiss Rifles = Shooting Swiss rifles - mostly K-31's at electronic 300 yd targets
- Tri-State = Winter Trap League that Shoots on a Sunday at Thurmont and at other Clubs across 3 States each on their Sundays
- UBR = Unlimited Bench Rest Shooting
- USPSA (IPSC) United States Practical Shooting Association. Usually finished on Sunday by 4 PM
- YHEC = Youth Hunter Education Challenge

JAC = Jacked Bullets - IPSC/IDPA/3-Gun/2-Gun/etc Steel Target Practice Bay. Max velocity = 1500 fps. No Rifles. No Shotgun slugs.

Lead = Lead & Frangible Bullets - SASS Steel Target Practice Bay. Max velocity = 1400 fps. Pistol Cartridge Rifles only. No slugs.

Paper = Frame available for paper targets. Other setups OK - be sure to clean-up when finished. Range Rules apply.
